- ➤ HB 2451 is in committee
  - o This bill is in reference to Electric Vehicle Training
- ➤ HB 2175 references the funding od the fire service in the Commonwealth
  - One current source of funding, and in many cases the only source, is through the ATL money.
  - President Wall had a letter sent to legislators in support of HB 2175
  - o This legislation will be to provide additional funding source and distribution method for the fire service
  - There will be a study conducted to the look at the additional funding at the cost of \$105,000.00
  - The Southwest Virginia Firefighters Association is a stakeholder in the legislation process

- ➤ Introduced Division Chief Dennis Price of Division VI and Division Chief Chad Stanley of Division IV

  - o This will change the method of testing in the Commonwealth
  - One advantage of this testing method will allow for quicker student results notification
    - VDFP will be able to bring a self contained testing site to a location
    - This unit will include tablets, WIFI capability and the ability to generate random test questions

- Reminded everyone to check on Cornerstone for upcoming classes as well as on demand classes
- > The Modular Firefighter I class is currently being field tested
- ➤ All HTR Programs have been reviewed and updated
  - o They will Pro Board and IFSAC accredited
  - o The ARRF class has been re-designed
- Fire Programs will be more supporting of training events and conferences
  - o The Division Chief's will be in the field more
- ➤ The Wise Regional School will be 9-11 September 2023
